

This edition of the Little Books contains the updated graphics with the first half of the lessons in Part One—lessons 1 to 33. Part 2 is coming!

The Little Books are designed to give extra reading practice for the lessons in Successful Sight Reading - Part One. Use them after the new vocabulary words have been taught. There are very few words in the little books that have not been taught in the lessons, so the students should be able to read the stories with confidence. You can use the books in group guided reading lessons, the students can read them independently and then take them home to practice the reading vocabulary.

The little books should not take the place of literature used in reading lessons. These little books are meant to be vocabulary practice. Re-read the books until the students are confident with the vocabulary and develop fluency.

With each lesson is a sheet with the new words and sentences to read. You can use these in a variety of ways. Enlarge them on the photocopier as big as possible and use them as a chart as you teach the lesson. They can be put up in the classroom and the students can use them as they 'read the room'.

You can give these vocabulary sheets to students who need extra practice. Have them find words and highlight them, circle or underline other words. Read the sentences together or individually. Send the little books home for extra practice.

To photocopy the little books:

Photocopy the little books double sided as they appear in this document. Fold the two pages in half.

If the little books are copied single sided, print off the 8 pages of a book. Put the pages the tall or portrait way.

Stack the pages in the following way from the top down:

Cover and back page facing right.

Page 2 - 7 facing left Page 6 - 3 facing right Page 4 - 5 facing left

Photocopy double-sided and fold in half.

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
The Clown






